To amend the Fair Credit Reporting Act to clarify the ability to use consumer reports in certain cases to establish and enforce child support payments.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Child Support Assist-
5 ance Act of 2014”.

1 **SEC. 2. USE OF CONSUMER REPORTS BY STATE OR LOCAL**
2 **CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES.**

3 Section 604(a) of the Fair Credit Reporting Act (15
4 U.S.C. 1681b(a)) is amended—

5 (1) in paragraph (4)—

6 (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking “or
7 determining the appropriate level of such pay-
8 ments” and inserting “, determining the appro-
9 priate level of such payments, or enforcing a
10 child support order, award, agreement, or judg-
11 ment”;

12 (B) in subparagraph (B), by adding “and”
13 at the end;

14 (C) by striking subparagraph (C); and

15 (D) by redesignating subparagraph (D) as
16 subparagraph (C);

17 (2) by striking paragraph (5); and

18 (3) by redesignating paragraph (6) as para-
19 graph (5).
