**A BILL**

To amend the Water Resources Development Act of 1996 to deauthorize the Ten Mile Creek Water Preserve Area Critical Restoration Project.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROJECT DEAUTHORIZATION.**

4 Section 528(b)(3) of the Water Resources Develop-  
5 ment Act of 1996 (Public Law 104–303; 110 Stat. 3768)  
6 is amended by adding at the end the following:

7 “(E) PROJECT DEAUTHORIZATION.—

1                   “(i) IN GENERAL.—The project identi-  
2                   fied as the ‘Ten Mile Creek Water Pre-  
3                   serve Area Critical Restoration Project’,  
4                   carried out pursuant to this paragraph,  
5                   shall no longer be authorized as a Federal  
6                   project upon execution of a transfer agree-  
7                   ment between the Secretary and the South  
8                   Florida Water Management District.

9                   “(ii) REQUIREMENT.—A transfer  
10                  agreement referred to in clause (i) shall re-  
11                  quire that the South Florida Water Man-  
12                  agement District operate the transferred  
13                  project as an environmental restoration  
14                  project to provide water storage and water  
15                  treatment options.”.
